Indirect Services

Holiday Share-A-Thon:

1st Sunday in December 2pm – 6pm at the Tioga Central High School

Bringing holiday cheer to over 150 children in the area. Each year we host a Holiday Dinner collecting toys for children in the Tioga Central School District. In addition we also put approximately 76 gift bags together for senior citizens in our community.

Parent to Parent:

program that is run on an on-call basis, to help parents learn to cope with their children's teen years and the issues that may arise during those years.

Nichols Flag Day:

June 14th, we host a program in conjunction with the Tioga Central School District students celebrating the American Flag.

Teens in Action:

a program designed to give teens a place to gather one night a week. Once a month these same teens go out into the community and help with service projects.

Make a Difference Day:

4th Saturday in October, CCNN identifies individuals in the community that need help with light household jobs and matches them to volunteers in the community.
